Normann Copenhagen Norm 12 Suspension was designed by Simon Karkov. The Norm 12 Suspension was named after its release year, which was 2012. Each Norm 12 suspension comprises 64 shade elements of hand-folded foil which has been wrapped around a skeleton structure for support. Norm 12 emits a warm and anti-glare glow which can be featured in both a commercial and residential setting. These self-assembly lights are incredibly easy to position and assemble without any need for glue or any tools.

Norm 12 Suspension is available in two sizes: large and extra large with an optional ceiling canopy. This Norm suspension light can be installed above dining areas, hallways or bedrooms independently or in a cluster for a beautiful visual feature. [Norm Collection](#) further includes two more suspensions designed by Karkov, the Norm 06 and original Norm 69 as well as the Norm 03 which was designed by Britt Kornum specifically for Normann Copenhagen.

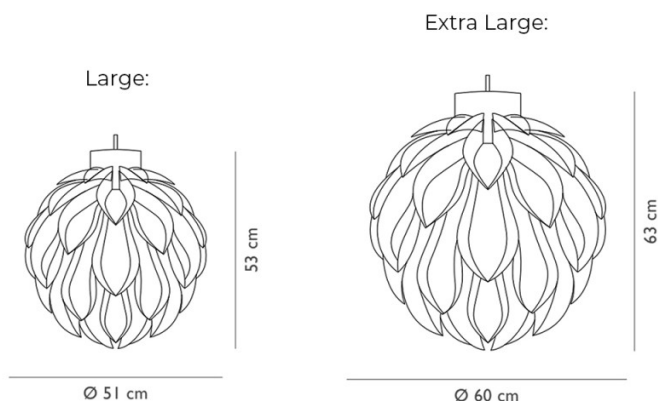
